

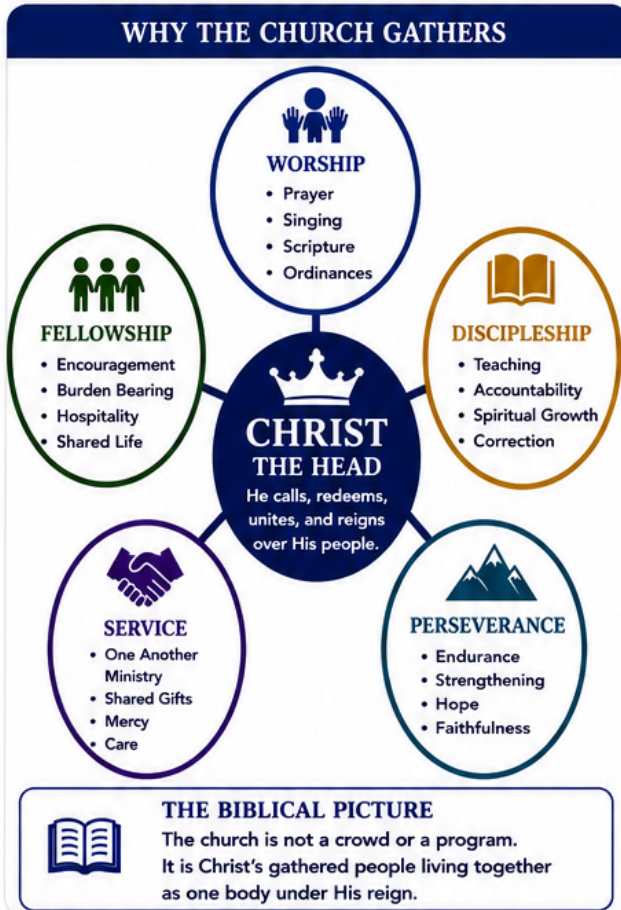


# Christianity Cannot Be Lived Alone

## CHRIST FORMS HIS PEOPLE THROUGH GATHERED COVENANT LIFE

Scripture presents Christianity as shared life under Christ, not isolated spirituality. Believers are called into gathered worship, fellowship, discipleship, encouragement, correction, service, and covenant participation together as one body.

### KEY SCRIPTURES

**Hebrews 10:24-25**  
"And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."

**Acts 2:42**  
"And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers."

**1 Corinthians 12:12-27**  
"For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ."

**Ephesians 4:15-16**  
"...but speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: from whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love."

"Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ."

- ✓ Christianity is embodied covenant life.
  - ✓ Christ gathers His people together.
  - ✓ Isolation weakens spiritual growth.
  - ✓ Fellowship is more than casual friendship.
  - ✓ Every believer participates in ministry.
  - ✓ God forms believers through shared life.

### THE BOTTOM LINE

The Christian life is personal, but it is not meant to be solitary. Christ gathers His people into worship, fellowship, service, and shared covenant life so they may grow, persevere, and bear witness together under His reign.

### TEACHER NOTE

Use this handout to help learners understand why gathering matters. Emphasize that biblical Christianity involves visible participation in worship, fellowship, discipleship, service, and one another ministry within the body of Christ.
