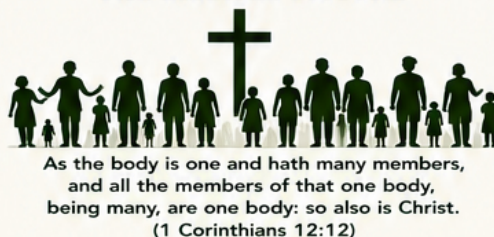
HOW UNITY STRENGTHENS THE CHURCH

THE BIBLICAL PICTURE



★ KEY TRUTHS

- ✓ Christ is the Head of the church.
- ✓ The church is one body with many members.
- ✓ Different gifts strengthen the body together.
- ✓ Humility protects unity.
- ✓ Division weakens witness.
- ✓ Christ forms His people through shared life.



THE BOTTOM LINE

Christ joins His people together as one body under His reign. Through shared worship, humility, service, truth, and covenant love, believers grow together into a mature and faithful Gospel community.



TEACHER NOTE

Use this handout to help learners understand biblical unity within the church. Emphasize that the church is not built around personalities or factions, but around Christ, shared worship, humble service, and covenant participation together. Diversity of gifts is a strength, not a threat, when the Head is Christ.



PRAYER FOCUS

Pray for unity in your church, that Christ would grow His body in love, truth, and humility, and that your church would be a clear and compelling witness to the Gospel in your community.
