BIG IDEA

Jesus calls believers to actively love, encourage, serve, forgive, strengthen, and care for one another. Church life is not passive attendance — it is shared life under Christ.

SESSION GOALS

By the end of this session, students should understand:

- ✓ Christianity involves shared responsibility.
- ✓ Jesus commands believers to love one another.
- ✓ Encouragement strengthens faith.
- ✓ Serving others reflects Christ.
- ✓ Church life should involve participation, not spectatorship.
- ✓ Christian community requires intentional care.



LEADER TIP

Some students may feel invisible, excluded, or disconnected.

Encourage students gently without forcing vulnerability.

Focus on:
creating a culture of encouragement and belonging.



OPENING ACTIVITY “Can You Carry It Alone?”

SUPPLIES:

- Heavy backpack or tote bag
- Several books or weights

STEP 1



Ask for one volunteer. Have them carry the heavy bag across the room alone.

Ask: “What made that difficult?”

STEP 2



Now ask 2–3 students to help carry it together.

Ask: “What changed?”

TRANSITION

Say:

“God never intended believers to carry life alone. Christians are called to help one another follow Jesus.”



This activity will connect extremely well emotionally.



YOUR ROLE

- ✓ Encourage participation
- ✓ Model kindness and listening
- ✓ Help students think relationally
- ✓ Connect discussion back to Scripture
- ✓ Keep Christ at the center
